FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the purpose of DRPT's I-95/I-395 Transit/Transportation Demand Management Study?

- To develop a plan for enhancing transit and transportation demand management (TDM) services as part of the I-95 / I-395 High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lane Project

What are the goals of the study?

- To maintain transit ridership, carpooling, and vanpooling while implementing the HOT lane improvements
- To utilize the new HOT lane features to attract new transit riders, carpoolers, and vanpoolers

How will the alternative improvements be identified?

- Current and projected travel in the study corridor
- Travel survey documenting behavior and opinions in the corridor
- Recommendations by local, regional and federal agencies/jurisdictions
- Public input

What opportunities will there be for the public to stay involved in the process?

- Public information meetings
- Comment forms
- Project website

What are the next steps for the study?

- September 2007 - Complete alternatives development
- October 2007 - Evaluate alternatives
- October 2007 - Develop cost/revenue projections and investment plan
- December 2007 - Prepare findings and final report
