



Richmond Regional Transit Vision Plan

The Vision Plan includes a robust outreach process to engage:

- Elected leaders regarding the need for and benefits of expanded transit
- Local staff leaders to align land use and multimodal transportation planning to foster successful transit in support of regional economic, environmental and other goals
- The business and development community to promote greater understanding of the various benefits of transit
- Citizens to understand needs, opportunities and challenges for expanded regional transit.

To meet these goals, the Vision Plan process will use public meetings, presentations to elected officials, and a Regional Transit Forum (Advisory Committee). The RTF will include representatives of various organizations who will guide the development of the Vision, Goals and Objectives for the Plan, provide input on alternatives and recommendations and help facilitate conversations with their respective organizations. This Advisory Committee includes representatives from a broad cross section of the region.
